It takes an unlikely figure, a shepherd boy named David, with an unwavering faith in God who slays Go-

Many of us face similar situations today. It may not be a literal giant holding us captive. Our giant may be fear, addiction, anger, rejection or even comfort that has control of us. These giants paralyze us, causing us to not live in the fullness and freedom of life that God has intended for us.

"Goliath *MUST* Fall" is the DVD study **GIFT** will be using this year. Led by Pastor Louie Giglio he examines the story of David and Goliath to reveal how we must slay our giants.
