Preaching this Morning at Advent

GIFT...GROWING IN FAITH TOGETHER.... At Advent "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine" (Isaiah 43:1) We are told many times in the Bible not to fear. It is necessary to keep repeating this because fear and its close relatives: worry, stress, and terror), may be the biggest giants we face personally and in our world. As Goliath taunted the Israelites, the giant of fear looms over us, taunting us each day. We may dread going to our mailboxes as there always seems to be a new bill in there awaiting payment. There aren't too many times, we actually get a check in the mail. We turn on the news, whether it is the television, radio, or one of our many electronic devices and we are assaulted by tragedies in our world. The news seems to downplay the good that does go on in our world. Perhaps we worry about a family member, friend, neighbor or ourselves who may need help medically, financially or spiritually. Our list of fears seems endless.

As we learned in session one of "Goliath MUST Fall", the giant is dead, but it can still be deadly. Jesus' resurrection shows us that God has power even over death itself and there is nothing that we will ever face that he cannot overcome. We can show those around us that we serve an all-powerful God when we refuse to give into fear, and choose to trust that Jesus has overthrown this giant! "Fear MUST Fall" is the topic for session two in our DVD study. With Pastor Louie Giglio's guidance we will learn concrete steps that we can take to develop a deep trust in Jesus. David wrote these words in Psalm 34:4 "I sought the Lord, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears."

Our next **GIFT** DVD study of "Goliath *MUST* Fall" is on November 18 from 11:30 to 12:30. Each of the sessions stand alone and will make sense even if you were unable to attend the previous month. If you wish, you may bring a packed lunch with you to have during the DVD. We hope that you join us as we grow in our faith together and hear anew that God wants us to live free and that God wants our giants to fall.
