Preaching this Morning at Advent

Advent welcomes Pastor Paul Laursen to our 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. services today. Pastor Laursen will be with us through November and beyond.

GIFT...GROWING IN FAITH TOGETHER...at Advent Our DVD study of "Goliath MUST Fall" continues this morning from 11:30 to 12:30. We are told many times in the Bible not to fear. This repetition is necessary as fear and its close relatives worry; stress and terror are perhaps the biggest giants we face personally and in the world. Our list of fears seems endless. We are told in Isaiah 41:13 "For I am the Lord, your God, who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you."

"Fear MUST Fall" is the topic of this morning's study. With Pastor Louie Giglio's guidance we will learn concrete steps that we can take to develop a deep trust in Jesus. We will learn that it is through Jesus, the one and only giant slayer that our giants WILL fall! Each of the sessions stands alone and will make sense even if you were unable to attend the previous month. We hope that you join us this morning as we grow in our faith together and hear anew that God wants us to live free and that God wants our giants to fall.
