# The Church in Babylon - Five False Gospels within the Evangelical Church, Part 4: The Gospel of Sexual **Preference**

"We must distinguish between homosexual inclinations and acting on them. We must distinguish between respect for people & agreeing with their behavior. We must counter the widespread notion that those who accept the LGBT lifestyle agenda have taken the high road; they, after all, are about 'inclusion' and not 'exclusion'. They represent 'love' not 'hate'." Christians should care enough to get to know the whole person. If you think that identifying as LGBT is mainly about sex — that's shallow. The theology of "whom we have sex with" might be black and white, but the person and related experiences aren't. Care enough about a person not to reduce them to their sexual orientation.

A challenging topic. One we must become more informed about so we can pro-actively be loving and compassionate "salt" and "light" in our culture – speaking the truth in love, but speaking the truth. Come and let's see how the Holy Spirit empowers us to be "salt" and "light".
