GIFT...GROWING IN FAITH TOGETHER...at Advent

Does it seem that the world is filled with angry people? Psychologist Leon Seltzer says that the brain secretes a hormone which is a painkiller when we feel angry. If that is the case then, the anger helps to numb us to whatever feeling triggered the anger to begin with. Perhaps that feeling is fear or hurt or the pain of having been rejected. Anger can make us feel that we are in control... even when we lose control of the anger. But, as Christians we have been taught it is not okay to get angry. We may bury our anger and smile and say it's okay, or that we've forgiven someone who hurt us, or that we are over it. In fact it may be that deep down we are not over it nor have we let go of that fear, hurt or rejection that caused the anger to begin with. Pastor Louie Giglio in this session, "Anger *Must* Fall", states 'we want the person we are angry at to pay a price for wrongdoing.' God is a God of justice, so going to him with our anger is the best thing we could possibly do with it'. In this session we will come to terms with our anger and look at what is involved in dealing with it in a positive way. We start by acknowledging we aren't perfect and learn that God has reconciled us to himself. Even though anger may feel good at that moment, if we bury it, or express it wrongly, anger harms us and others. Freedom from anger is at hand and through God anger *will* fall.
