The Church in Babylon – Jesus at the Church Door – Prayerless Pulpits, Satisfied Saints and Spiritual Blindness

"So, because you are lukewarm—neither hot nor cold—I am about to spit you out of my mouth!" Rev. 3:16. Wow! Talk about tough love. These words from Jesus speaking to the church in Laodicea are haunting. Do they apply just to that church? Or to churches today? Even to Advent? Why did Jesus find himself outside the Laodicean church door, knocking and asking to be invited back in? Is He outside our doors? Do we need to invite Him into Advent? If so, how? And what rewards does Jesus promise to those who take up His glorious invitation? This is Dr. Lutzer's favorite chapter, and it's one of the toughest to face. Come, let's face it together in humility, repentance and hope.

GIFT...GROWING IN FAITH TOGETHER...at Advent

This year in **GIFT** we have been using the DVD series "Goliath *Must* Fall" by Louie Giglio pastor of the Passion City Church and founder of The Passion Movement. He has guided us through many different possible giants that we may have in our own lives. In the conclusion of this series, Pastor Giglio asks us to look at the giant of addiction. We can get addicted to anything that promises our brains a reward they crave. Scientists have found that our brains release the chemical dopamine that is linked to happiness when we get that reward. Addiction may be to alcohol, nicotine, shopping, overeating, our phones or quite simply to the approval of others. We can become addicted to anything that we feel we can't do without, anything we turn to when life is in chaos or if we feel we are in a slump. Pastor Louie will help us examine the root cause of addiction and what it takes to get free from it. When we realize that it is God to whom we must turn, we can say goodbye to an addiction that we may have had at our heels for years and understand that we don't need to be controlled by anything. It is then that the giant of addiction *will* fall.

Please join us following the 10:00 a.m. service on June 9 for the conclusion of the "Goliath *Must* Fall" series. Each session stands alone, so if you have missed any of the previous ones, this session will make sense. We hope that you join us as we continue to learn and grow in our faith together.
