# **Intercessory Prayer at Advent – After the 10:00** Service, 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of the Month

Advent has a history of emphasizing prayer in our worship services as part of our liturgy; - prayer in the rear of the sanctuary during administration of Holy Communion at the 10:00 a.m. Service, prayers during choir practices, prayers on Wednesday mornings, prayers for Advent parishioners not able to join us during Sunday services, prayers for the Eliza Jennings residents, prayer teams lifting up the sick and afflicted during the healing service when Bishop Love came for his visitation, prayer vigils during Lent, and impromptu prayers as the Spirit leads us during services.

We are restarting our corporate Intercessory Prayer time the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of each month after the 10:00 a.m. Service. We have a sign-up sheet on a table at the rear entrance to the sanctuary for folks to add first names (their own or others) aligned with prayer requests for spiritual healing, physical healing, relationships, thanks & praise, infilling of the Holy Spirit, joy & peace, inner/emotional healing, deliverance, wisdom & guidance, and faith & strength. We invite parishioners to join us for 45 minutes or so. You don't need to be a seasoned prayer warrior, nor be gifted with creating impromptu prayers. Just come!

What is Intercessory Prayer? Intercessory prayer is prayer for others. An intercessor is one who takes the place of another or pleads another's case. One study Bible defines intercession as "holy, believing, persevering prayer whereby someone pleads with God on behalf of another or others who desperately need God's intervention." Jesus was an intercessor while He was here on earth. He prayed for those who were sick and possessed by demons. He prayed for His disciples. He even prayed for you and me when He interceded for all those who would believe in Him. Jesus continued His ministry of intercession after His death and resurrection when He returned to Heaven. He now serves as our intercessor in Heaven. And He calls for us to be intercessors on behalf of others. It's our privilege and our honor. Come join us!
