### LENT

Lent is the 6-week/40 day (excluding Sundays) period leading up to Easter, the most important festival in the Christian calendar. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Easter, with the last week of Lent being called Holy Week. Lent is a time of sacrifice and remembrance as we remember when Jesus went into the desert to fast and pray before beginning his work for God. During this time Jesus was tempted several times by Satan, but was able to resist. On Ash Wednesday, we attend a service during which we are marked on the forehead with a cross of ashes as a symbol of our recognition and admission of sin and our mortality. Lent is a time of discipline, sacrifice and preparation. In lieu of giving up a favorite food, you may wish to consider a more meaningful discipline, such as adding a time of daily worship or devotion to your schedule. Reading your Bible or a devotional book each day, or special Lenten services, are appropriate Lenten disciplines.
