## Presiding Bishop Michael Curry's Word to the Church: Holy Week and Easter Day 2020 Online Worship Supported and Encouraged

"Last week I stated publicly my support for bishops who, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, decide "for a designated period of time . . . to cancel in-person gatherings for public worship." I write now concerning the need to suspend in-person gatherings for public worship, in most contexts, during the sacred time of Holy Week and Easter Day. Because this is a global health crisis, the principles in this letter apply throughout The Episcopal Church, including beyond the United States."

Therefore, there will be no services on Palm Sunday, during Holy Week, and on Easter Sunday. Certainly not being able to celebrate Easter as a community of believers is a blow to us all. The Lord will sustain us.

In the days ahead we will be taking steps to stay connected as a congregation during these tumultuous times, through phone calls, emails, and snail mail. Frequent versions of ADVENTures will be one way. We'll suggest content useful for private worship on Sundays and other times; prayers of support for one another; ways to encourage the faith of our congregation; and take other steps to help overcome the social isolation and loneliness that many will experience. The lack of corporate worship, restrictions on face-to-face interactions, restrictions on groups of 10 or more meeting, and social distancing keep us apart.

Please call JoAnn at the office (440-871-6685) or Dick (440-413-0189) or Ray (440-821-8057) with any needs or prayer requests. We need to know from you those who are ill, those in need of special prayers, and those who just need to hear a friendly voice from the faith community of Advent.

Continue to hold up in prayer our flock, our national/state/local leaders, our first responders and medical practitioners on the front line facing and fighting the diseases and putting themselves in great harm, and family care givers supporting those who are ill. As I wrote earlier, please communicate with the rest of us any who you learn are ill with COVID-19 or other illnesses. I had conversations with people this week who are really fearful and uncertain about the future. This is our opportunity to be Christ's light to the world of followers and non-followers. The COVID-19 may well be an opportunity for spiritual revival. Keep the faith!
