All services at Advent are scheduled for Sunday at 9:00 a.m. We will be celebrating the Holy Eucharist with a special service.

The Spirit of Truth

John 14:15-17

If you love Me, you will keep My commandments. ¹⁶ I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever; ¹⁷ that is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him, but you know Him because He abides with you and will be in you.

As we get ready to start meeting together this Sunday morning, my newsletter mini-messages will cease and be replaced live with gestures! This week we are reflecting on John 14 as Jesus prepares His followers for His soon departure.

Isaiah prophesied that the day would come when the virgin would conceive and give birth to Immanuel, God with us. This joyful news was announced to Joseph when an angel of the Lord appeared to him. For about thirty incredible years, God dwelt among His own people, as the Word became flesh and tabernacled among us, full of grace and truth.

Jesus was indeed **God with us**, but He told His disciples of an even more staggering truth, that the time was fast approaching when the Holy Spirit would be sent into the heart of every believer, and this would be, **God within us**.

The limited reach of the Lord Jesus in His earthly life, in His human body, extended only to those that were physically with Him. The miraculous reach of the Holy Spirit as a Person is such that no matter where we go, or what we do, God, the Holy Spirit goes with us, because He is, **God within us**. The Lord did a work for us but since the cross, resurrection and ascension, it is the Holy Spirit of Truth Who works within us.

The promise that God the Holy Spirit will be in us was given to the disciples just before Jesus finished His work of redemption on the cross of Calvary. Jesus stated that the world is incapable of receiving the Spirit of God for they do not know Him, but those who have trusted Christ as Savior do know the Holy Spirit.

Herod's Temple was destroyed in the 70's AD. But on Pentecost the new Temple within the heart of every believer was constructed!

At Pentecost that promise was fulfilled, and from that day to this, all who trust on Jesus Christ as Savior have God, the Holy Spirit with us and all around us, above us and beneath us, but He is also within us. He came to make our human bodies His permanent dwelling place, the Temple of God.

Only when God the Son went to be with God the Father could God the Holy Spirit take up permanent residence within the bodies of all who are born from above. That is what we celebrate on Pentecost.

This is the core of our faith and walk today. I encourage you to grasp it at a bit deeper level and ask the Holy Spirit to guard and guide your walk today. As Jesus promised, if you love Him and keep His commandments, which were just two, to love the Lord with all your heart, and your neighbor as yourself, He will do that!

Pentecost
