Tornado Victims Need Our Financial Help and Prayers

We've all seen the devastation from the tornadoes that ripped through Kentucky, Tennessee, Missouri, and elsewhere. Can we even comprehend what Westlake would look like were it to have happened here? Years ago, Advent provided financial support and 2 separate work crews of Advent parishioners to do Katrina hurricane relief work at and through St. John's Episcopal Church in Pascagoula, MS. I searched for Episcopal Churches in Mayfield, KY, and found an African Methodist Episcopal (AME) church. St. James AME Church was at 419 S. 8th Street. According to their Facebook page, the church building was destroyed. The Rev. Gloria Lasco writes "We know that the next few days and weeks will be busy and challenging but we serve a God who always provides. We ask for continued prayers and thank everyone for your continued support." A faith like that is worthy of help, hope and encouragement. Let's collect funds over the next 3 Sundays. On the memo line write "St. James AME Church", place it in the collection plate or send it to the office, and we'll pool money for their recovery. I'm reminded of Jesus' words from Matthew 25:40 "The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.
