Advent's First Half Financial Performance is Ahead of Budget

Your faithful giving continues to inspire us! For the January – June period of 2022, total revenues are more than \$6,100 ahead of budget and expenses are \$5,600 less than budget. The budgeted deficit for this period was (\$16,600), but thanks to the above, the actual deficit is only (\$4,800). As of June 30, Advent's unrestricted cash reserves are \$183,500 – effectively this is Advent's rainy-day savings account. At the beginning of 2022 this reserve balance was \$188,300. Paying for repairs to the broken waste sewer line in the basement, implementing needed landscaping by non-parishioner service providers, and other facilities expenditures will add to this deficit and draw down the cash reserve. Vestry voted these non-budgeted expenditures to keep the condition of Advent to be attractive and welcoming to current parishioners and those in the future that the Lord has in mind for this house of God.
