## **Bless Our Schools Sunday**

Churches unite globally to pray for students, teachers, and schools. This prayer activity is organized by Mom's in Prayer International, Claim Your Campus, and Christian Educators.

### **To bless our schools please pray ...**

## **Advent Financial Support for Relief of the Needy in Ukraine**

Advent disbursed \$2,795 to Samaritan's Purse and \$2,620 to Feed My Starving Children to buoy recovery efforts in Ukraine devastated by war. Funds are a combination of vestry-authorized and individual parishioner contributions. Samaritan's Purse is a nondenominational evangelical Christian organization providing spiritual and physical aid to hurting people around the world. Samaritan's Purse is committed to meeting the rapidly growing physical and spiritual needs of families in crisis in Ukraine. Five medical facilities operate throughout the country to provide robust non-medical relief response. They collaborate with local churches to purchase, transport, and distribute massive quantities of food and items such as hygiene kits, blankets, and warm clothing. Samaritan's Purse has served nearly 3 million people throughout the first five months of this Ukrainian response.

Feed My Starving Children, a partner with Food for the Poor, is a Christian nonprofit organization called to feed God's starving children hungry in body and spirit. FMSC provides food aid consisting of MannaPack fortified rice meals. MannaPack Rice is an excellent source of protein, carbohydrates and key nutrients culturally acceptable worldwide for anyone over the age of one. Each meal costs less than 25 cents to make and 15,311,000 have been distributed in Ukraine as of August 2.

Each offering by these organizations is an opportunity to remind families in Ukraine that the Lord cares for and has not abandoned them during their time of need. Thanks to all the Advent family for easing the burden of these suffering children of God.

## **From the Jr. Warden:**

I wanted to recap last Sunday. The landscaping around the building takes a considerable amount of time to do properly. With the vestry's approval I found a contractor willing to do the work. This is not to be confused with cutting the grass. That is a separate service.

Nick's 4 Seasons Services is the company I am currently using. I had used him before and got good results. It's always nice to have an idea how well someone performs before you hire them. Nick is responsible for the area immediately around the building. He did a major clean up to get the grounds looking good.

I had another contractor do work on the island. That was Home & Property Services. Contact Matt Such. Matt did an excellent job getting the island back in shape.

I contracted Four Seasons (Nick) to come back every week and clean up the property around the building. This would include weeding, mulching, taking out dead plants & leaf removal around the entrance ways. This will last until November. This should keep our property looking well cared for throughout the summer & into the fall.

To recap, we currently have 4 contractors maintaining the property at Advent.
