Paul's Missionary Trip to Nepal

You have heard discussion in this newsletter as well as during on Sunday services over the past couple of weeks regarding my mission trip to at least three locations in Nepal. I am so grateful for Advent's decision to prayerfully and financially support this trip through Word and Deed Ministries.

As we have begun more in depth planning, as the Lord provides the financing for this major initiative, now estimated to be between \$12 to 15,000, we have been invited to also do some pioneering work in Nepal as well as Bangladesh, and finally to minister in northern India. Our prayerful thought is that with the initial outlay for the trip to Nepal, it might be good stewardship to extend the trip a bit to make it as impactful as possible.

This means that I will be gone beyond two weeks as originally expected.
