# Earthquake Relief for Victims in Turkey

Advent supported Ukrainian war refugees last year through Samaritan's Purse and Feed My Starving Children in the combined amount of \$5,415 - donated by individual parishioners and from Advent's Outreach funds. Now the world faces another humanitarian and spiritual calamity. The death toll surpassed 50,000 on Feb. 24th from the 7.8 magnitude earthquake and large aftershocks in Turkey and Syria that started on Feb. 6. Turkey declared more than 44,000 people dead and Syria almost 6,000. The situation in Syria amounts to a "catastrophe on top of a catastrophe," as the country has experienced suffering from 12 years of civil war. Eye witnesses describe "apocalyptic" scenes in southern Turkey. "Entire neighborhoods have been flattened; homes destroyed, schools and shops closed; lives torn apart. The scale of devastation here is truly incomprehensible".

Kathryn for many years has been a part of Word & Deed Ministries. She and Paul went to Nepal and Bangladesh under that ministry banner. Word & Deed is a Reformed Christian ministry that focuses on meeting the spiritual and physical needs of people in accordance with biblical principles for the glory of God. Its approach is to act as a bridge connecting Christian churches, businesses, and individuals in North America with churches and missions in the developing world so that together they can reach out in the name of Christ to those in need.

Please pray for those whose lives are devastated in Turkey and Syria, that they may experience Christ's hope and comfort during their dire circumstances. Vestry voted to appropriate \$3,000 from our Outreach budget for humanitarian aid to Turkey, to be channeled through Word & Deed Ministries. We invite parishioners to individually add their contributions. If you choose to do so, place "Turkey" in the memo line of your check. Thank you.

### Mission Trip to Liberia

After the Ark of the Covenant had been restored to Jerusalem to the tent that King David had established for it, a team of worshipers were set in place. They then offered up thanks to the Lord. On Palm Sunday we honor the Lord joyfully, even though we know that Good Friday is coming for Jesus.

In King David's day the following two verses were a part of that celebration. 1 Chronicles 16:23-24 (NASB) Sing to the LORD, all the earth; Proclaim good tidings of His salvation from day to day. 24 Tell of His glory among the nations, His wonderful deeds among all the peoples.

Kathryn and I are also offering thanksgiving for your ongoing support so that we might continue our overseas missions work. We will be jetting off to Liberia two days after Easter; we return home on May 4. You may have heard that my bride started ministering in Liberia in 2004; for me this will be my first trip to this African nation.

Evangelism will of course be a focal point. Along with outreach, we will be doing discipleship training for younger leaders as well as for new converts so that effective leaders will emerge for the Kingdom in the months ahead. Please pray for safe travel as well as divine health throughout our trip! From the US, we travel to Brussels on the 11th, on to Freetown, Sierra Leone. From there to the capital of Liberia, Monrovia.

On the way home we go through Sierra Leone to Casablanca, Morocco. From there we zoom into London for a brief stayover to see Kathryn's mother and family. From London we come into Newark and then onto Cleveland! We pray that the itinerary holds!
