## **Messages from Kathryn:**

### **Liberia**

Please would you put a note in the Advent-ures regarding a shipment going out in 2 or 3 weeks to Liberia for Christmas. We are hoping to send gifts for the children: small toys, school supplies etc. and if anyone would like to donate towards the shipping. It costs \$220 per barrel to ship. We also normally send \$300. for at least one community to eat a good meal on Christmas day. If anyone is interested in helping, please write checks to Word and Deed Ministries. Your donations are tax deductible.

### **Nepal**

Please pray for Nepal at this time. The young people are rising up against the corruption and control of the government. There is rioting in the streets, clashes between the demonstrators and the police. over 20 killed and over 200 hurt. This is where Paul and I will be traveling to on November 6th for 3 weeks.
