URGENT APPEAL FROM LOVE IN THE NAME OF CHRIST

For several years, Advent has financially supported the ministry Love INC (Love in The Name of Christ). Again, this year Advent will provide them \$750. When Advent receives requests from non-parishioners for various forms of help (prayer, financial help, clothes, housing, personal items, etc.) we refer them to Love INC. Dear Church Partner,

I am writing to you today with a heavy heart and deep humility. Love INC of Cuyahoga County has been faithfully serving our neighbors in need — meeting practical needs, building relationships, and sharing the love of Christ for almost 30 years — but at this time, our ministry is facing a serious financial strain that we can no longer shoulder alone. This is not something new, and I have worked hard to get us back on solid ground. Unfortunately, since August, we have been operating on faith, "limping along" to continue answering calls and providing care with limited resources. We've trusted God each step of the way, and He has been faithful, but the reality is that our funds are nearly depleted. Our **Fall Fundraiser**, which we prayed would bring stability, has brought in only about \$3,500 so far. We are still believing in a big financial provision.

Despite every effort to reestablish the health of this ministry — reducing staff, scaling back services, and relying on volunteers — our resources are now critically low. Until we see how God provides through the remainder of this fundraiser and any other means of financial support, we have made the difficult decision to **pause all financial assistance to neighbors in need**. If you are referring someone to us, this is what they will hear on the voice message:

"Thank you for calling Love INC of Cuyahoga County's resource center. Unfortunately, we are not able to process applications for assistance at this time due to lack of funding.

If you are calling for another reason, please spell your first and last name, phone number and reason for your call. God bless you"

So please make sure to email us about them and contact information.

We will continue to serve through our Clothing Closet, Baby Depot, Furniture and Toiletry Ministry, and we can provide your church with an updated Resource Referral List to help direct neighbors to other available community support.

This is not an easy message to write. It grieves me deeply because I know how many lives are touched through this ministry every single week — families who find hope, stability, and a glimpse of Jesus' love through your partnership and our collective work. We are continuing to trust in the Lord's provision and believe that He will move through His people — the local Church — to help sustain this vital work.

Thank you for being part of the body of Christ that lifts others up when the burden grows heavy. Your partnership **truly makes the difference** between doors staying open or closing.
